

Karl Rove, who dodged the draft in order to avoid going to Vietnam, helped set in motion the U.S. invasions of Afghanistan and Iraq. As George W. Bush's chief political strategist, he helped promote the expanded use of torture, and he orchestrated efforts to sell the invasion of Iraq with false information about weapons of mass destruction.

Rove, who recently published an unrepentant autobiographical memoir, is speaking at Hopkins as part of the MSE Symposium.
